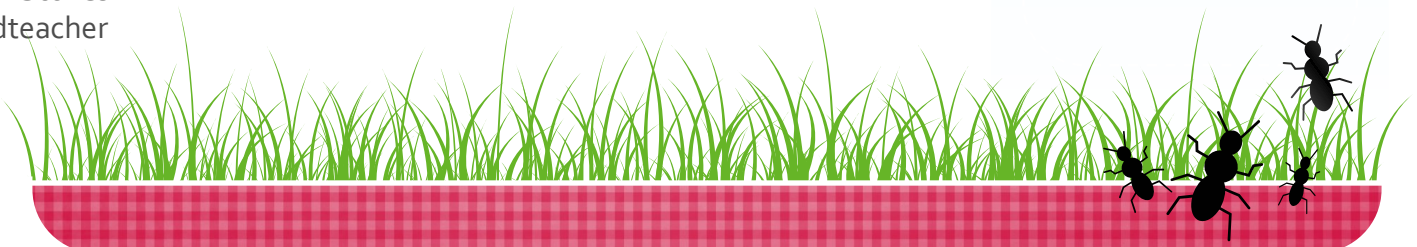
## Attendance
